P3G may use this information in the terms set forth in this agreement to further the objectives described above. Your material will not be sold or transfer under the custodianship of another entity.

P3G will make every effort to inform users about these terms and conditions but we cannot be held responsible for uses that would be made in contravention to the rules set forth in the Observatory.

You should send to P3G any updates of your material, as they become available. P3G wants to offer a reliable and high quality website to the international community. It will make every effort to keep its website up to date. However, you should hold P3G harmless should there be discrepancy between the data posted on the Observatory and the data submitted.

P3G does not collect or disclose to any third party research project data pertaining to identifiable participants. P3G has a policy on privacy. In order to respect your right to privacy, P3G will make available on its website only the personal information provided in the questionnaire for the purpose of sharing on our website, such as the name of the lead researcher, the coordinators and the contact information you provided to P3G for the purpose of posting it on the website. You are responsible to obtain all the authorizations pertaining to private information disclosed in the questionnaire, prior to filling the form.

At any time, you may revoke your consent to the foregoing by providing P3G with a written notice requesting that your material be withdrawn from the Observatory. P3G will answer and comply with your request within ten (10) working days, and provide you a written confirmation of the deletion. Also, P3G reserves the right to withdraw your material from its website at any time. P3G being supported solely by public funds, you should know that the website could terminate its operation at any time.
